KISS & DROP – APOLLO AVENUE

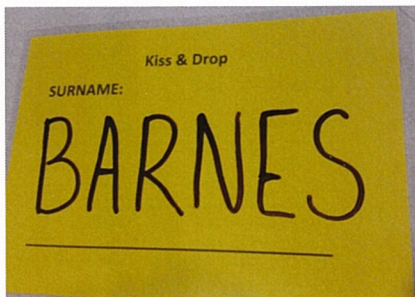

Dear WPPS families and carers,

In Term 3 WPPS will be adopting the Kiss & Drop practices recommended by Transport for NSW. These changes are necessary due to the growing concern over unsafe practices in the Apollo Avenue Kiss & Drop zone.

If you use the Kiss & Drop zone you will be required to place a name card on display in the windscreen (passenger side) so that you can be easily identified by the school staff supervising the area. This will allow staff to call your child/ren for collection as you approach the turning circle in Apollo Avenue.

Enclosed in this envelope is a blank name card, please write your surname on it in large writing (see pictures below). You may wish to affix the name card to your car sun visor or alternatively just place it in the passenger side of the windscreen when needed.



Kiss & Drop safety tips for drivers and students are also printed on the back of the name card for easy reference. Additional name cards can be collected from the school office.

West Pymble Public School - Kiss and Drop Code of Conduct

Drivers:

- Always drop off or pick up your child from the designated zone and follow the school's procedures
- Drivers should remain in their vehicles at all times in the Kiss and Drop zone
- Make sure children use the Safety Door (the rear footpath side door) to get in and out of the car
- Make sure the handbrake is applied when the vehicle is stationary
- Always park legally
- Avoid unnecessary dangerous manoeuvres such as U-turns and three-point turns

Students:

- Always get in and out of the vehicle through the Safety Door, the rear footpath side door
- Stay buckled up until the vehicle has stopped in the Drop-off and pick-up area
- Make sure your school bag and other items are in a safe position, such as on the floor
- Be ready to get out of the vehicle with your belongings when the car has stopped and you have unbuckled your seat belt

We appreciate your assistance in keeping our children safe during busy school drop off and pick up times.
