Welcome Back

Welcome back to another new term. I hope everyone has had a refreshing and relaxing holiday. We are hopeful of an

uninterrupted and settled term ahead. Many of our internal activities can resume, although there are some that are still on hold, most notably New Student Enrolment activities and overnight excursions. SRE/SEE recommenced this week and Band rehearsals last week. All authorised visit ors to the school are required to complete and sign in at the office as part of the COVID safe processes implanted by the NSW Government. Please ensure your child/ren are kept at home if they are not well and for absences longer than three days a medical certificate is required.

We are still required to ask parents and visitors to stay off site. All enquiries should be directed to the Office on 9144 7584. If you need to deliver/collect anyone or anything from school, please ensure you come to the Tristania Place entrance and one of the Office ladies will pop out to meet you. You can also use the gate buzzer to call the Office from this entrance. There is unrestricted parking in Tristania, as opposed to Apollo which is the designated Kiss and Drop Zone.

GERRIC

Once again, thank you to our community for allowing us the luxury of time to complete this 16 hour course over the first two days of Term 3. Many of you will know that we have been working securing mutually agreeable dates between GERRIC and the School since I first took it to the P&C for approval back in 2018. The GERRIC Mini Certificate of Gifted Education (COGE) is highly sought after and securing suitable dates has been a long and arduous course, but one that has been well worth the wait! The Mini COGE has been an absolute highlight for all of us. We are now one of very few schools where all staff are fully trained in gifted and high potential education. I personally found the course to be one of the most rewarding and enriching professional learning experiences that I have engaged in over my many years as an educator and a learner.

What a lovely surprise! We came out of the GERRIC Session in the Hall on Tuesday to find the fencing had been erected and the work had commenced on the current phase of the playground. Due to COVID restrictions some mentor aspects have had to be changed to avoid "cross pollination" between schools. Our mentors for the program are Year 9 students from Turramurra High School. The program will run for the entire term, culminating in a community awareness campaign and Expo at the end of the term.

Spell-a-thon

This week your child would have received information about the P&Cs main fundraising initiative for 2020. As all other fundraising has been cancelled for 2020, we're hoping our WPPS families can dig deep and support their child and our school for this event.

This term all WPPS students will be participating in the Spell-a-thon. This is a fun and educational fundraiser where students will be required to learn 10 spelling words which have been developed by their teachers. During the two week learning phase students are encouraged to collect sponsors to support them in their learning. Sponsors can choose to support your child on a per word basis or alternatively they can do a lump sum contribution.

On Tuesday, week 4, all students will sit the Spell-a-thon and be required to write their spelling words on a test paper. The P&C will collect the answer sheets and hand them back so that students and their sponsors know how much they are to contribute.

This is by no means a competitive activity. There are prizes for the classes with the most correctly spelled out words and prizes for the classes who raise the most money. Last year we raised over \$11,000 which is an amazing effort. Let's try and beat that this year!


