Apollo Ave

There is new signage and additional road markings in Apollo Avenue to assist with Kiss and Drop. Thank you to Tamara Leo for contacting KMC Road Safety Officer Maria Leotta and working closely with her to initiate the changes. There is now a line on the road to indicate where cars should wait before entering the turning circle. This is to prevent tailgating and other unsafe practices which inhibit clear visibility of the road. There is also additional signage to this effect. Please be aware of these new safety measures to ensure the ongoing safety of our children.

Storm Damage

If you are not already aware, we have sustained storm damage to the Tristania Avenue gates. Students are required to enter the school via the driveway and not the pedestrian path which is blocked. We hope to have this situation remedied soon as it is now in the hands of Assets and the Department's insurance company.

COVID Update

We look forward to the further easing of COVID restrictions in the new year. As these guidelines are complex, they are taking careful consideration to digest and are a constant state of flux. I will let you know early in the new school year about restrictions on parents and visitors entering the school grounds. At this stage it appears to be drop off at the gates and leave in the morning and in the afternoon it will be the same procedure in reverse, collect and leave, but I will confirm these guidelines for you at a later date.

Holiday Message

I hope that after this topsy turvy year, our whole school community takes the opportunity to refresh, relax and spend valuable time with families. Congratulations to everyone who has not only survived 2020 but who has grown and thrived.

This year has been one of disruption but also one of great opportunity to re-examine what we do, how we do it and why we do it. It has also been a year to develop many new skills, independence, resilience, social and emotional maturity, technology and additionally for us as educators, our pedagogy in delivering a true future focused education. Collaboration, communication, creativity, curiosity and critical thinking and problem solving (the 5Cs) have really established their prominence in education. During remote learning, our children were afforded the opportunity to play more and of course it is through play that these skills are developed and consolidated. 


