Book Week Activities

A big thank you to Mrs Matkovich for arranging a wonderful book week. Over the last two weeks WPPS has celebrated Book Week 2020, "Curious Creatures, Wild Minds" with a number of activities. We invited adventurer, film maker and author, Tim Cope, to present interactive incursions to the children on Tuesday 27 October, which was not only thoroughly enjoyed by all but gave us great insights into leading an enriching and fulfilling life. Tuesday 3 November saw the curious creatures and wild minds come to life, with a number of activities presented by the Library throughout the day, including a costume parade, treasure trawl and reading under the trees. The costumes created by students and staff were wild as the day became curiouser and curiouser!

New Student Orientation and Transition

Next Tuesday will see the first of our Taste of Kindergarten sessions. Please come to the Apollo Avenue gates between 9:00am and 9:30am, where you will be met by staff. Your children will be escorted in to the Kindergarten rooms where they will participate in a number of typical Kindergarten class activities with the current Kindergarten teachers. Remembrance Day

School Development Days (SDDs)

The NSW Department of Education has made a change to the delivery of SDDs commencing in 2021. There will be two SDDs at the start of the year, Wednesday 27 and Thursday 28 January, with students in Years 1-6 returning on Friday 29 January. Kindergarten students will be engaged in Best Start interviews from Friday 29 January till Tuesday 2 February, with their enrolment day being Wednesday 3 February. The Best Start interviews are by appointment and you will soon receive information on how to book your appointment.

The SDDs for Terms 2 and 3 remain unchanged with the first day of each term designated a professional learning and planning day. There will only be one SDD at the end of Term 4.





Active and Creative Kids Program

The NSW Government is helping kids get active with the new Active Kids and Creative Kids program.

Parents, guardians and carers can apply for a voucher valued up to \$100 per calendar year for each student enrolled in school.

The Sports voucher may be used with a registered activity provider for registration, participation and membership costs for sport, fitness and active recreation activities.

The Creative voucher may be used with a registered activity provider for registration, participation and tuition costs for creative arts, speech, drama, dance, digital design, coding, and music lessons and activities.
