Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back

We are now in the final run to the end of the year and what a roller coaster ride it has been! We can't thank you enough for the active role you have taken in your child's education since the start of lockdown. There have been many positives that have emerged, increased partnerships and a greater understanding of the role of teachers in your child's education, students discovering more about their preferred styles of learning with many becoming increasingly self-directed in their work habits.

We are very excited to see them all come streaming through the school gates again starting on Monday for Kindergarten and Year 1 and then the following Monday for all other year groups.

It is understandable that many will be feeling a little disconnected and anxious but please reassure them that this is normal. If your child is feeling a little nervous, please encourage them to let their teachers know as they are best placed to ease those worries, knowing your children as they do.

You can help by re-establishing routines and acknowledging their feelings, actively listening to them and helping them to find solutions. If you can encourage them to discover the solutions to their worries, they will have more ownership and feel more invested in putting those strategies in place when they return to school. We will be doing the same when they return. All of our students will be engaging in a unit of work called "We Belong" developed by Mr Benedet and which has had input from all staff. This will be in place for the rest of Term 4 to help children re-connect with each other and their teachers and help them explore positive emotions, such as joy, gratitude, kindness, amongst others. There will be a different focus each week through until the end of the term.

It has been amazing to see the increased collegiality between staff over this period and I would like to give a big shout out to all our teachers and support staff who have worked as one over this entire lockdown period to ensure the best for our children and to look after each other. We have always been a very collegial staff but the bar has been raised to a level that I have never experienced before. With Australian Teachers' Day coming up on 29 October, every one of our staff deserves to be acknowledged.


