Dear Parents and Carers,

## Welcome

A very warm welcome to our new students, Ollie R (4J), Ed R (2F) and Henry R (KG) and Mertyll G (2F). The boys joined us at the start of the Term 3 and have been a part of the essential workers' group, so have had an opportunity to familiarise themselves with the school and form some friendships. Mertyll started with us just this week and is adapting to her new school and its routines beautifully.

## Welcome Back!

In Week 3, our Kindergarten and Year 1 students returned and settled back in delightfully. Their smiles were enormous as they eagerly came though the school gates. This week, all remaining year groups had their turn and they were equally impressive. We are so happy to see everyone back on site, back with their teachers and their friends, where they should be.

## **COVID** Roadmap

The roadmap back to school is subject to change depending on current DoE and NSW Health advice. You can stay up to date by checking the Advice for Families page at Advice for families (nsw.gov.au)

A reminder that anyone who has the mildest of COVID\_19 symptoms must get tested immediately and self\_ isolate until they get a negative result even if they are vaccinated.

From 18 October all staff onsite are required to be fully vaccinated. You can have confidence that we are handling the evidence requirements with the department and anyone interacting directly with students is fully vaccinated. Students

are being kept with their Stage cohorts with dedicated teachers assigned to each cohort. Stages have their allocated areas of the playground to avoid mingling. While specialist teachers will be unable to deliver their lessons face to face, they will still be able to deliver virtual lessons to each of the other Stages.

Parents are not permitted onsite. If you need to contact the office, please call on 9144 7584. If you are dropping off or collecting during the school day, please come to the Tristania gates and ring the office either from the key pad or from your mobile and a staff member will come out to greet you.

It has been pleasing to see the large numbers of students wearing masks. While these are not mandatory for primary school students, they are strongly recommended. All staff wear masks inside. Outside is no longer a requirement.

The ventilation audit of all public NSW schools is complete and our school report indicates that our natural ventilation is sufficient to accommodate each of our classes in the rooms. The department's ventilation recommendations have been informed by NSW Health advice, expert advice from the Doherty Institute and the World Health Organisation. Should air quality decline, the DoE has remediation steps in place. The weather has been very conducive to outdoor learning since our students have returned and it is wonderful to see our students and their teachers taking full advantage for their lessons.

WPPS has recently moved from Level 4 to Level 3 plus restrictions. The current advice will remain in place until we move to Level 3 restrictions.

## Kindergarten Enrolment

Our face to face "Taste of Kindergarten" sessions have been put on hold due to the restrictions, so we are busy planning virtual sessions for you. The first of these is planned for Week 7. We have pushed the dates back as far as possible in the hope that we might be able to hold face to face sessions should the situation change. Watch this space for further details.

If you are yet to enrol, please submit your enrolment application as soon as possible. Likewise, if you will not be returning to WPPS in 2022, please let us know. Our planning is well underway for next year and is entirely dependent upon student enrolment.

## Semester 2 Reports - Parent Reflection

A big congratulations on surviving the home learning period. It was a difficult time for all involved, and the staff are extremely appreciative of the level of assistance our school community gave to support the teaching and learning of the students.

In line with advice from the NSW Department of Education, our school reports for Semester 2, 2021 have been adjusted to cater for students learning from home. The report will focus on English and mathematics achievement and provide information about student attendance, commitment to the home learning period and identify learning goals.

As the students have spent the vast majority of Semester 2 in remote learning, we have a unique opportunity to include both student and parent reflections in this report. Teachers will gather the required information from students at school.

We are asking all parents to fill in a short survey to gauge your assessment of how your child/ren performed in remote learning. This short survey should take no longer than 2 or 3 minutes to complete. A separate survey will need to be completed for each of your children. Parent input will form a valuable component of the revised report format for this semester. We sincerely hope everyone will take the time to complete the survey.

## Check-in Assessments Years 3-6

Students at West Pymble PS in Years 3-6 will be completing a Check-in assessment in both Reading and Numeracy across the next 3 weeks. These assessments are intended to supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

Please note, parents will not receive feedback on student performance at the completion of the check-in assessment.

The Check-in assessment includes two online assessments for Years 3-6 students:

- reading assessment
- numeracy assessment

Each assessment is designed to be quick and easy to administer, consisting of approximately 40 multiple choice questions.

The assessments will be conducted in the school computer room between 1 November and 15 November.

It would greatly benefit the students if they brought in a set of headphones from home. They will need to be plugged into either a jack or USB port. We are unable to support Bluetooth headphones at this time. These headphones can be kept in a safe place in the classroom. Once the assessments have been completed, the students can take them home.
