



School Uniform Procedures

West Pymble Public School uniform procedure was decided at a special general meeting which unanimously endorsed the wearing of the school uniform by the students of this school. These procedures support the NSW Department of Education Uniform Policy PD-2004-0025-V2.0.4, last updated 13 May 2021. West Pymble Public School insists on sensible standards of clothing, grooming and personal cleanliness. The advantage of wearing school uniform includes the fostering of pride and a sense of belonging to this school; reduces undesirable distinctions because of clothing; provides identification and increases security for the children. We thank all parents for their support in this matter.

- Hats are compulsory all year.
- Summer uniform is worn in the Summer months – Terms 1 and 4, Winter uniform in the Winter months – Terms 2 and 3. The changeover dates are set by the school and notified to parents via the newsletter. All articles of clothing should be clearly labelled.
- Boys' Summer and Winter shirts **MUST** be tucked in.
- If for some reason uniforms cannot be adhered to, students should bring a note explaining the circumstances.
- For all excursions and performances, there will be a statement of uniform requirements.
- All students (K-6) are required to wear a sports uniform on their designated sport day.
- **No jewellery** (apart from ear studs and watches).

Uniform requirements

All uniform requirements are readily available from the Uniform Shop, which is open during term every Tuesday between 2:30pm and 3:30pm and Thursday between 8:30am and 9:30am. This is situated in E Block next to the Library. Some items are readily available from retail outlets. # **Please note that tracksuits are not uniform.**
